



Frequently Asked Questions - FAQs

How will I find my tree when I go to decorate?

Each tree will have an 11" x 7" Sign with the name of the sponsor on it. Enjoy a nice stroll through the many trees and find your name.

How big are the trees?

Each tree will be 5 to 6 feet tall. Bring your step stools.

Can I add extra lights to the tree?

No, please do not turn your tree into a fire hazard by adding more lights and burning down the city. We do not need another urban renewal project in Laconia.

Can I add my business or organization logo to the sign?

Yes, you can send your logo to connect@celebratelaconia.org and we will add your logo to the sign. As we know the holidays are all about advertising and sales. Be part of the proud holiday tradition. We suggest sending a scalable vector graphic image to ensure that your logo is clearly displayed. (.eps, .png, or .pdf are best formats)

Do I have to decorate the tree? I would like to sponsor one but I do not want to decorate it.

No, but your name will be on the tree and you will be shunned by the community for your naked tree. Shame...Shame...Shame. Celebrate Laconia is completing the hardest part by setting up and lighting the tree. All you have to do is the fun part and put on the decorations. Donating
